Gerald F. Masoudi is Deputy Assistant Attorney General in charge of International, Policy, and Appellate Matters in the Antitrust Division at the U.S. Department of Justice. He is the Chairman of the Merger Working Group of the International Competition Network. He previously was Principal Deputy Chief Counsel at the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA), where he also served for a time as Acting Chief Counsel. Before joining the FDA in 2004, he was a partner in trial and appellate litigation at Kirkland and Ellis, L.L.P. in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Masoudi earned his B.A. in economics from Amherst College in 1990. In 1993, he graduated with high honors from the University of Chicago Law School, where he served as an editor of the University of Chicago Law Review and was a John M. Olin Fellow in Law and Economics. Upon graduation, he clerked for Judge Frank H. Easterbrook of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit.
