Article L752-26 French Commercial Code

(Rough translation)

In case of abuse of a dominant position or economic dependence on the part of a company or group of companies operating one or more retail stores, the Competition Authority may proceed to injunctions and penalties provided for in Article L. 464-2.

If the injunctions and financial penalties applied have failed to end the abuse of dominant position or economic dependence, the Competition Authority may, by a reasoned decision after receiving comments company or group of companies involved, order him to alter, amend or terminate, within a specified period, all agreements and all acts by which economic power is made that allowed these abuses. It can, under the same conditions, order him to proceed with the sale of surfaces, if this assignment is the only way to ensure effective competition in the trading area in question.
