André Nollkaemper is Professor of Public International Law and Director of the Amsterdam Center for International Law at the faculty of Law of the Universiteit van Amsterdam.

Previous academic positions include Fellow of the Royal Academy of Sciences at Erasmus University Rotterdam, Visiting Scholar at the School of Law , University of Washington, Seattle and Research fellow at the Netherlands Institute for the Law of the Sea (NILOS) / Institute of Public International Law , University of Utrecht.

He is member of the Advisory Commission on Public International Law of the Netherlands and the Standing Committee of Experts in International Refugee and Criminal Law and of-counsel at Bohler, Franken Koppen Wijngaarden advocaten in Amsterdam.

His practical experience includes cases before the International Court of Justice, the European Court on Human Rights, the Special Court for Sierra Leone, the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia, courts of the Netherlands and consultancy for a variety of international and national organisations.
