On 16 November, BIICL is hosting an event looking at various issues arising in relation with the cross-border enforcement of judgments. The keynote speaker will be The Hon RS French AC, Chief Justice of Australia. His talk will focus on recent decisions of the High Court of Australia involving international law questions including the registration and enforcement of foreign judgments as well as foreign state immunities in relation to the enforcement of judgments.
