

CALL FOR PAPERS FROM THE OXFORD UNIVERSITY COMMONWEALTH LAW JOURNAL

The Oxford University Commonwealth Law Journal (OUCLJ) is the flagship journal of Oxford University's postgraduate law community, produced under the aegis of the Law Faculty. It is published twice annually and endeavours to foster international academic debate and exchange on a wide range of legal topics of interest throughout the Commonwealth.

The OUCLJ welcomes contributions from academic lawyers, practitioners and policy-makers, wherever situated. Submissions on all branches of law are welcome. Pieces may include analysis of non-Commonwealth law, but are selected on the basis that they are likely to be of interest to a larger Commonwealth audience. The OUCLJ publishes articles which are concerned with a single jurisdiction as well as those which undertake a comparative analysis, with an emphasis on black-letter law rather than legal theory. All pieces are double blind refereed.

Because of the high volume of submissions received and the nature of the Journal as a forum for legal specialists, the Journal does not in practice publish pieces written by students.

The OUCLJ enjoys the support of a strong group of patrons from across the Commonwealth, including Lord Goff of Chieveley (UK), Justice Hayne (Australia), Mr Justice Cameron (South Africa), Justice Manohar (India), Justice Sharpe JA (Canada), Chief Justice Smellie (Cayman Islands) and Mr Justice Ribeiro PJ (Hong Kong).

Submissions:

Submissions may be in the form of articles, opinion pieces, and book reviews. The Journal sets no minimum length for submitted pieces, but they should generally not exceed 10,000 words (articles) or 5,000 words (book reviews and case notes).

All submissions should be in Microsoft Word electronic format, using 12 pt Times New Roman font, and double-spacing. Citations must conform to the Oxford Standard for Citation of Legal Authorities, which can be found at <http://www.competition-law.ox.ac.uk/published/oscola.shtml>.
