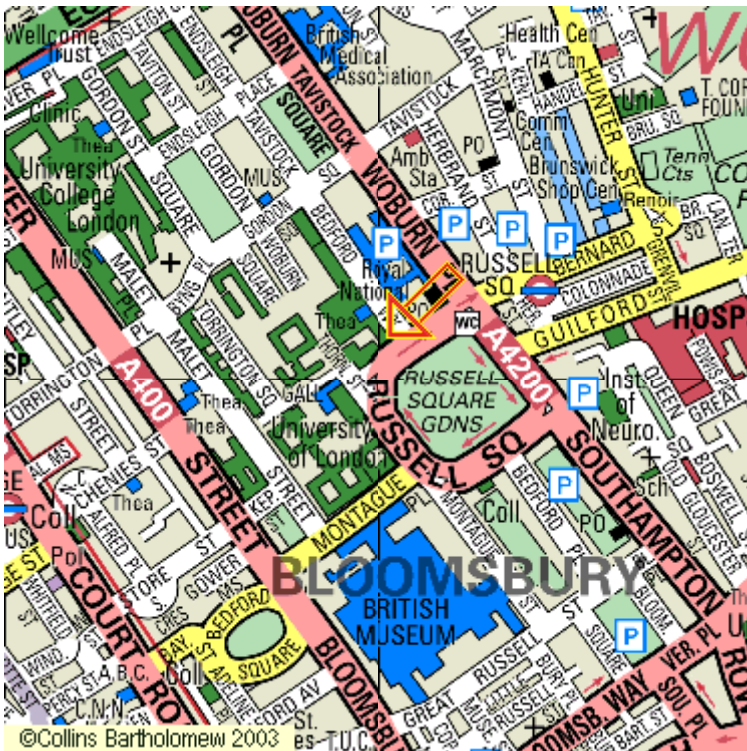

By tube:

Russell Square (Piccadilly line) is the closest underground station.

By bus:

Bus routes 59, 68, 91, 188 all go along Southampton Row, close to the Institute.

By rail:

Euston and King's Cross mainline stations are within 10-15 minutes walking distance of Russell Square.

By Air:

From Heathrow

It is possible to travel directly from Heathrow Airport to Russell Square on the underground (Piccadilly Line, journey time approximately 45 minutes).

Alternatively, the Heathrow Express takes about 20 minutes to get to Paddington, from where you can take the tube to King's Cross (District/Circle/Metropolitan Line) and then change to the Piccadilly Line to Russell Square.

From Gatwick

There is a Thames Link rail service from Gatwick to Kings Cross, and also a British rail service and express service from Gatwick to Victoria station. Taxis are also available at any of the mainline London stations.

By Eurostar:

Trains come into London Waterloo mainline station. The bus routes below all stop at Waterloo Road outside Waterloo station.

By road:

Very limited parking is available in the streets near the Institute. There are public car parks on Bedford Way, Woburn/Coram Street and Marchmount Street.
